

Paediatric First Aid

First aid covers a multitude of skill sets and responses to many medical situations. Its primary aim is to provide immediate first aid medical care and treatment until professional medical assistance arrives.

The aim of this course is to equip you with the theoretical knowledge needed to deal with paediatric first aid situations, basic life support, CPR, shock, fractures, bleeds and a range of other minor illnesses and injuries. Ideal as CPD (Continued Professional Development) training for qualified paediatric first aiders in a nursery, school, pre-school environments, childcares and parents.

Please note theory only knowledge is not a substitute for classroom based regulated paediatric training. Practical competence is a requisite to completing a regulated first aid qualification.
